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RULES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF EXAMINATION

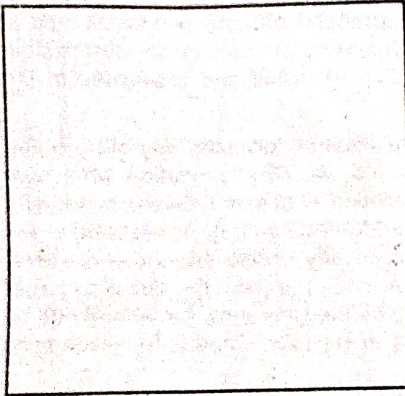
1. The Examination shall be held on the dates and the programme notified.
2. A candidate suffering from any illness or disease which renders his presence in any way prejudicial to the general body of students under examination will not be allowed into the examination rooms and be removed if found there in. The Superintendent, however, may if possible, make special arrangement for his examination in a separate room.
3. The doors of the examination rooms will be opened an hour before the time of the examination for first paper on the first day and 15 minutes before the time of the examination for subsequent papers and will be closed punctually 5 minutes before the time of the examination. A candidate may be admitted to the examination if he is late by not more than half an hour.
4. Two papers unless otherwise notified, will be given on each day.
5. Candidates will be required to give their answer book to the officer-in-charge of room precisely at the expiry of time of the examination or whenever they complete their paper. The answer paper must on no account be left on the desk or taken away.
6. An answer paper once submitted shall on no account be handed back to the examinee under any circumstances.
7. A seat with a number corresponding to that on the receipt granted by the controller of Exam. will be allotted to each candidate. Candidate will be required to sit in their allotted seats. Changing of seats is not permissible except by the permission of the Centre Superintendent, which shall be duly recorded and forwarded to the University at the close of the examination.
8. Any candidate detected in helping another or attempting to obtain unfair assistance, or using any other unfair means to gain an improper advantage in the examination, shall be expelled. No communication whatsoever between candidate, while in the examination, shall be allowed. Candidates are not permitted to have in their possession in the examination room, umbrellas, books, memoranda, pocket books, notes etc. or any loose papers whatsoever (even if these papers are in no way connected with the subject under examination) except the question paper set by the examiner, the Controller of Exam. receipt, and the book provided by the University for writing out the answer with a sheet of blotting paper and the instrument etc. mentioned in rule 23. Candidate, disobeying these rules will be expelled.
9. Before commencing to write answers each candidate shall write on the cover page of his answer books his Roll number and Registration number, but not his name or college. Candidate are warned that unless the candidate's Roll number and Registration number are clearly written on the answer paper, it will not be examined.
10. Any candidate who attempts to render the identification of his answer paper impossible or difficult will be liable to exclusion from the examination.
11. If a candidate is found guilty of making any objectionable or improper remarks in his answer paper name shall be reported to the University for such action as the circumstances may require.
12. Candidates are forbidden to write any answer (on anything else) of the question paper, or on the blotting paper.
13. Candidates are forbidden to write any answer (on anything else) of the question paper, admission card that have been given to them.
14. Candidates for all examinations must sign their names when directed to do so by the officer-in charge of the room.
15. Candidates should write on both sides of the paper in their answer books. They may however reserve one or two pages for rough work either in the beginning or at the end of their answer book but the pages should be crossed and folded before submitting the answer book.
16. No candidate will be allowed to hand over his answer-book until an hour has elapsed from the time when the papers are given out.
17. No candidate without permission of officer-in charge of the room is to leave his seat, of the examination room until the end of the examination.
18. No candidate shall be allowed to re-enter the examination room during the hours of the examination after once quitting. During the hours of examination, if temporarily leave the examination room but during his stay outside he must be under the surveillance of a thoroughly trustworthy person to be deputed by the officer-in charge for the purpose; No candidate however, shall be allowed to leave the examination at all of the Centre Superintendent who will make special arrangement for his surveillance.
19. Any candidate wishing to ask any question of the officer in charge will rise from his seat and remain standing until the officer-in-charge come to him. He will, on no account, leave his seat nor will be allowed to make any noise to draw the attention of the officer in-charge.
20. Friends and guardians of candidate will not be allowed to enter the examination room or any adjacent part of the building for any reason what except on the morning of the first day of examination when they will be required to retire from the rooms and building half an hour before the examination time. On any other day or in the afternoon of the first day the entrance of unconcerned persons into the rooms or building reserved for the examination or adjacent part is strictly forbidden.
21. Precisely five minutes before the time fixed for giving out the question paper a warning bell will be rung as signal for all candidate to take seats. After the warning bell has been rung any outsider remaining in the hall or neighbourhood within the compound where the examination is to be held will be expelled as being guilty of trespass.
